The Aalborg Commitments

The Aalborg Commitments are a consensual declaration for action by local governments working together across Europe, adopted at the 'Aalborg+10 – inspiring futures' conference in June 2004, building upon the sustainability principals of the 1994 Aalborg Charter.

With its signature, Municipality of Ravenna

has affirmed its commitment to sustainable local development and Local Agenda 21, to strategic and coordinated action for an inclusive, prosperous, creative and sustainable community with a high quality of life for all, and to enabling its citizens' participation in all aspects of urban life.

The signatory has further undertaken to implement the review, target-setting and implementation plans appended to the Aalborg Commitments document, in cooperation with its fellow signatories and local partners, and specifically to:

- produce a baseline review within 12 months of signing,
- engage in a local participatory target setting process,
- prioritise action, aiming to address all ten Commitments,
- set local targets within 24 months of signing,
- make a regular Aalborg Commitments progress review available to citizens and
- provide information on targets and progress for regular European assessments.

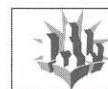
